## WORK TO RESULT IN TEMPORARY OVERNIGHT RAMP CLOSURE ON NORTHBOUND I-95

**WHAT:** The northbound I-95 ramp to Dundalk Avenue (Exit 58) will be closed overnight. The **detour** will direct motorists from northbound I-95 to Eastern Avenue (Exit 59), to Kane Street, to Dundalk Avenue.

**WHEN:** **Weather permitting**, the ramp closure will occur **Tuesday, April 4, and Wednesday, April 5, from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.** the following morning.

**WHY:** **Toll Dollars At Work.** Crews will close the ramp to pour foundations as part of the Maryland Transportation Authority's (MDTA) \$13.7 million project to remove and replace weathering steel high-mast light poles along I-95 in Baltimore.
