Parking along Riverview Avenue

Be advised that the Maryland Port Administration (MPA) and the Maryland Transportation Authority (MdTA) Police discourages port workers from parking their personal vehicles along any residential streets, and specifically Riverview Avenue (next to Airport Grill). The MPA has received numerous community complaints and we need to be respectful of our surrounding communities. Individuals, who need to park off-terminal, must utilize other public locations other than Riverview Avenue.

Special accommodations are allowed for individuals employed at MPA terminals if they are operating a vehicle that does not display a current vehicle decal. If the need arises to enter a terminal without a valid decal, you may contact your employer regarding the access procedures for the 14-day Vehicle Permit issued by the MdTA Police.
