Controlled Burn-off on Dundalk Marine Terminal

Between 5:30 and 6:00 p.m. this evening, the Maryland Port Administration will begin a controlled burn-off of three storage tanks of compressed natural gas (CNG) on the Dundalk Marine Terminal. At points, the flames could reach up to 40 feet high and possibly be visible from surrounding communities. At no point does this controlled burn-off present any danger to area neighborhoods nor will it effect Port operations. The purpose for the burn-off is to eliminate the existing CNG tanks that will no longer be used by the MPA. The Baltimore City Fire Department will be on hand during the process.

The Baltimore City Fire Department, Baltimore Gas & Electric, Maryland Department of Environment, Maryland Transportation Authority Police, Maryland Port Administration and MPA Operations have been involved and informed of the operation.
