

The Handling Instructions for Tesla Model S SOP will provide instructions on how to operate the Model S vehicle and also key processes such as; speed limits, parking, and powering off/on the vehicle.

Driving Instructions:

Opening Door:

*Door handle will extend when you walk up to it, as long as you have key with you.

*If handles don't extend, lightly press on the handle itself

Using the key:

To familiarize yourself with the key, think of it as a miniature version of Model S, with the Tesla "T" representing the front.


REAR TRUNK

Click to unlock or to open/close a powered liftgate

Single-click to stop/start the movement of a powered liftgate

FRONT TRUNK

Click to unlock



LOCK/UNLOCK ALL

Double-click to unlock doors (lights flash twice and handles extend)

Single-click to lock doors and the trunks (lights flash once and handles retract)

Press and hold to lower all windows

Starting and Driving the Vehicle:

*Select a Gear: Press brake and move gear selector all the way down for D (drive) and all the way up for R (reverse)

Speed Limits:

Vehicle Yard:

The speed limit in the Vehicle Yard is 16kph.

Perimeter of Facility:

The speed limit around the perimeter of the plant is 33kph.

Inside the Building:

The speed limit inside the building is 8kph.

Parking:

1. Park vehicle so doors do not make contact with adjacent objects.
2. Press button at end of gear selector to put vehicle in Park.




3. Once vehicle is in Park, the touch screen will show "Car is in Park"



4. Make sure the steering wheel is in a straight position.



5. Put keys in the cup holder.




6. Make sure the seat cover is on correctly and floor mat is in place after exiting the vehicle.




Sleep Mode/Power Off:

1. Touch Screen:
 - A. Press on Controls in the bottom left corner of the screen
 - B. Press Power Off in the middle of the screen



2. Confirm to Power Off by pressing Power Off in the middle of the screen.



3. The vehicle will now be completely powered off.

Power On:

1. The vehicle is turned back on by pressing the brake pedal. The screen behind the steering wheel will light up once the vehicle is back on.
