CHANGING TRAFFIC PATTERNS ON NORTHBOUND & SOUTHBOUND I-95 IN BALTIMORE THIS WEEK

#i95bmore

WHAT: **Southbound I-95** traffic lanes will split with two lanes to the left and two lanes to the right from Exit 53 (I-395) to Exit 50 (Caton Avenue). During this phase, there is no merge lane on southbound I-95 for the Washington Boulevard on-ramp and for the Caton Avenue exit (Exit 50). Traffic entering southbound I-95 from Washington Boulevard must YIELD.

Northbound I-95 traffic lanes will shift with all four lanes to the left from Exit 50 (Caton Avenue) to Exit 52 (Russell Street).



Northbound I-95

WHEN: **Weather permitting**, the **southbound I-95** split from Exit 53 to Exit 50 will be in effect by **Tuesday, June 2**, for approximately three weeks.

Weather permitting, the **northbound I-95** shift from Exit 50 to Exit 52 will be in effect by **Thursday, June 4**, for approximately two to three weeks.

WHY: **Toll Dollars At Work:** The split traffic patterns and shifts are part of the Maryland Transportation Authority's (MDTA) two-year, \$64 million project to remove and replace the existing concrete deck (riding) surface and roadway joints on mainline I-95 and ramps in Baltimore City.

REMINDER: *Automated Speed Enforcement (ASE) equipment is deployed on northbound I-95 between Exit 50 (Caton Avenue) and the Fort McHenry Tunnel. The work-zone speed limit is 50 mph on northbound and southbound I-95.*
