


PUBLIC INPUT REQUESTED

Dundalk Marine Terminal, Resiliency Improvements

The Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Port Administration (MPA) and the USDOT Maritime Administration (MARAD) invite your comments on a project to improve resiliency and stormwater drainage at the Dundalk Marine Terminal. This project will improve the ability of the Terminal to withstand future storm events and sea level rise due to climate change. The purpose of this announcement is to present the proposed improvements and provide an opportunity for public comment. Comments and questions provided in writing during the Public Comment Period (30 days in duration) will be taken into consideration as project planning continues.

Project Description

The project is located wholly within the MPA's Dundalk Marine Terminal property. It consists of the installation of a new large storm drain pipe to increase stormwater drainage capacity; tidal gates to prevent tidally influenced water from entering the storm drains; and a 32" sea curb surrounding the Terminal to prevent overtopping of floodwater during storm surge events. No construction is proposed outside of the Dundalk Marine Terminal.



Why Is the Project Needed?

Strong storms are becoming more prevalent in our area and can cause adverse impacts to Terminal operations as a result of localized flooding. The improvements will better protect the terminal infrastructure, cargo, and personnel during extreme rainfall and storm surge events.
