

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has announced a tentative timeline for the reopening of the channel.

The Corps expects to open a channel 280-feet wide and 35-feet deep by the end of April and reopen the permanent 700-foot wide, 50-foot deep channel by the end of May.

Currently, vessel traffic into and out of the Port of Baltimore remains suspended. Trucks however are still being processed inside our marine terminals.
