**I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Kratos Public Safety and Security Solutions, Inc. ("Kratos") is the awardee of Contract No. 517811 under an Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Agreement of the Maryland Department of Information Technology (DOIT) Hardware 2012 Master Contract.


**III. BACKGROUND**


Modification No. 2 is for a change to the scope of the Contract. Kratos will no longer be providing licenses for two (2) virtual machines and four (4) core machines. This modification decreases the total contract value by \$11,222.43.

**IV. DETERMINATION**

- A. DOIT Hardware 2012 Master Contract meets the requirements of an intergovernmental cooperative purchasing agreement under COMAR 21.05.09.01B(2)(a).
- B. It is in the best interest of the Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Port Administration (MDOT MPA) to issue a modification to this contract because it decreases the total contract value for a scope that will not be performed by Kratos.
- C. Modification No. 2 decreases the total Contract value by \$11,222.43, for a revised total contract value of \$102,527.57.
- F. This modification is less than \$50,000, therefore approval from the Maryland Port Commission or the Board of Public Works is not required.


