The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Skilled Trade Specialist I, Plumber. Employees in this classification are required to perform plumbing work in accordance with all applicable local, state, and federal regulations and standard practices or rules governing the specific trade.

Employees in this classification perform other types of maintenance work as necessary. Such work requires physical exertion, with duties performed outdoors under all weather conditions or inside an MDOT building. Employees may be required to move objects weighing over 50 pounds on some assignments, and may also be required to work on equipment located in elevated locations and/or work in cramped quarters in buildings or underground. Skilled Trade Specialists are considered "essential" and are, therefore, subject to emergency call back procedures and may be required to work rotating shift work, to include evenings, nights, weekends, and holidays.

The current vacancy is located at the Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Port Authority (MDOT MPA) at the World Trade Center in Baltimore City. The eligible list resulting from this recruitment may be utilized for future Skilled Trade Specialist I, Plumber openings within MDOT.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

##### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

**Education:** Graduation from a standard high school or possession of a high school equivalency certificate.

**Experience:** Two years of experience performing skilled trade work in plumbing.

**Consideration for employment may be based solely on the contents of your application; therefore, it is essential that you provide complete and accurate information. Please include all relevant experience on your application. This includes, but is not limited to, full or part-time, volunteer, military, acting capacity, or any other experience that is relevant to the position you are applying.**

**Notes:**

1. Additional work experience performing skilled trades as defined above may be substituted on a year-for-year basis for the required education.
2. A certificate from a vocational technical school with a major in one or more of the skilled trades as defined above may be substituted for one year of the required general experience.
3. Candidates may substitute U.S. Armed Forces military service experience as a non-commissioned officer in utilities repair classifications or construction and engineering specialty codes in the skilled trades as defined above field of work, on a year-for-year basis for the required experience.

**LICENSES & CERTIFICATIONS:**

1. Candidates appointed to positions in this classification are assigned duties that require the operation of motor vehicles. Employees are required to possess a motor vehicle operator's license valid in the State of Maryland. **All applicants must list their license number and expiration date on the application.**
2. During the probationary period, employees may be required to obtain and maintain a Class A or Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) valid in the State of Maryland, depending on the type of equipment operated.
3. The employing administration may require employees to satisfy its agency training and certification program requirements to obtain and maintain permanent status in this classification.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

1. Employees must be willing and available for duty at such hours, day or night, as may be required to maintain continuous operation of a facility and are subject to call-in. Employees are required to maintain a reliable communication link for emergency call back requirements.
2. Employees that work with or may be exposed to hazardous materials, such as: asbestos, lead-based paint, or chromium, may be required to undergo periodic medical testing and may be required to pass hazardous materials training and can wear a respirator.
3. Applicants may be required to demonstrate the ability to perform maintenance work on high structures and in cramped quarters.
4. Candidates will be subject to pre-employment drug testing in accordance with the Transportation Code of Maryland Regulations 11.02.11, Testing for Illegal Use of Drugs.
5. Employees in this classification are subject to substance abuse testing in accordance with the Transportation Code of Maryland Regulations 11.02.11, Testing for Illegal Use of Drugs.
6. Employees in this classification are considered "Essential Employees" and must sign and agree to all policies and procedures relating to "Essential Employee" status.

Employees in this classification will be required to obtain a Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) to gain access to Maryland Port Administration facilities. **For information on how to apply for a TWIC card, please go to [www.tsa.gov/twic](http://www.tsa.gov/twic).**
