


Recent Improvements

Toll Reductions

Maryland open for Business

- The Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA) is providing new, lower toll rates for trucks using interstate toll facilities to access the Fairfield, Masonville, Dundalk and Seagirt Marine Terminals.
- Effective January 1, 2016, commercial-vehicle drivers with a valid E-Zpass Maryland account and transponder pay \$2 per axle for 3, 4, 5 and 6+ axle vehicles to use the I-895/Childs Street ramps at the Baltimore Harbor Tunnel or the I-695/Broening Highway turnaround at the Francis Scott Key Bridge.
- The lower toll rates are an incentive to help drivers save time by using interstate highways and reduce truck traffic on local community streets. Learn more about the new, lower toll rates at mdta.maryland.gov
